


Facts

- **81,289,699** inhabitants (19/10/2016)
- capital Berlin; divided into 16 federal states with their own parliaments
- democracy

 people are carrier of the government authority, the Germans vote for a representative body of the people
- **GDP**: 37,130 € (per inhabitant) (2015)

 Head of the state or President of the Federal Republic of Germany is Walter Steinmeier.

• The chancellor of Germany is **Angela Merkel**.





Evangelisches Gymnasium

- Protestant private school
- 742 pupils currently (from Year 5 to Year 12)
- about 70 staff members (teachers, caretakers...)
- full-time day school

Full-time day school

- Year 5 to Year 9: three full days from 7:55 to 15:30
- other activities after school and on short days (Tuesday and Friday 13:10)
 - → clubs such as sports and music (cooperations with other schools and clubs)
- Years 10 to 12 have long days every day according to their timetable

Subjects

- classic subjects as main subjects: Mathematics, German and English
- <u>Science department</u>: Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science and Biology
- <u>Languages</u>: English, Spanish, French, Latin, Italian (Russian and Chinese as clubs)
- Social studies: Political Science, Geography, History,
- Art and Music
- Religious Education: mandatory for all pupils
- Physical Education (variety of clubs: Football, Tennis...)
