CASPER DAVID FRIEDRICH

- born September 5, 1774 in Greifswald
- leading figure of the Romantic movement in Germany
- Member of the Royal Dresden Art Academy and Berlin Academy
- after 1835 he was nearly completely paralyzed
- died May 7, 1840 in Dresden
- Works: Das Eismeer („The Sea of Ice“) 1823-1824, Wanderer über dem Nebelmeer („The Wanderer above the Mists“) 1817-1818



FRANZ MARC

- born February 8, 1880 in Munich
- painter and printmaker
- key figure of the expressionist movement in Germany
- joined the „Neue Künstler Vereinigung“ (New Artists' Association) in 1910
- founding member of „Der blaue Reiter“ (The blue Rider) with Kandinsky in 1911
- died March 4, 1916 in France
- Works: Blaue Pferd („Blue Horse“) 1911, Der Tiger („The Tiger“), 1912



JOSEPH BEUYS

- born May 5, 1912 in Krefeld
- studied at the Art Academy in Düsseldorf
- worked with a group called Fluxus (a group of artists and musicians)
- part of the Neo-Dada, Conceptual Art and Fluxus movements
- political activist (founded the „Deutsche Studentenpartei, one of the first member of the „Grüne Partei“...)
- since 1964 part of every documenta (Exhibition of contemporary art in Kassel)
- died January 23, 1983 in Düsseldorf
- Works: "Wie man einem toten Hasen die Bilder erklärt" (How to Explain Pictures to a Dead Hare), 1965
"Fettecke"(1982





STREET ART

- All around the world, has also found its way into the German youth culture
- public places (walls, light poles etc..) get painted on and turned into an individual piece of art
- a lot of different styles and formats, vivid, provocative or simply amusing art pieces



ARCHITECTURE

- **diverse and heterogeneous architecture style**
- **ancient architecture: pre. Romanesque, Romanesque, gothic, renaissance, baroque, classicism, historicism, art nouveau, modern, nationalism, post- war reconstruction**
- **Many influences of different times in history**
