Salzwelten in Bad Sassendorf

- Placed in Bad Sassendorf
- •An interactive museum about the history of salt
- It has a regional salt route and an Adventure Exhibit
- Opened in spring 2015
- •There are a caverns full of crystal, an exhibition about salt, salt water and moor, a salt collector and a fictitious bath world for relaxation
